Course Launch

There will be an online course launch from 3:00 - 5:00pm on **Friday 16 October 2020** to provide support and professional development.

The launch will feature a presentation on Global Studies from Dr Matthew Davies, Senior Lecturer and Fellow of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, as well as presentations from the course developers, who will share sample Programs of Learning and assessment tasks that they have prepared for 2021.

Teachers will need to:

1. **Review the new course and rewrite their Programs of Learning, to include the content of the new course.**
2. **Develop assessment tasks that reflect the new course and requirements outlined in the *Humanities and Social Sciences Framework*.**
3. **Create new rubrics for each assessment task, using the new and separate Achievement Standards for Years 11 and 12.**

Writing a Program of Learning Online Course
