Vocational education and training (VET) programs provide students with opportunities to complete their secondary education whilst at the same time acquiring work skills and VET qualifications. Some students have combined their studies with part-time school-based apprenticeships and traineeships.

VET in schools programs deliver nationally recognised-qualifications that students can build on in their future studies. These programs also provide valuable career exploration opportunities. Students can determine career pathway preferences based on sound knowledge and experience.

Students who have achieved all the competencies for a Training Package qualification are awarded a vocational Certificate. Those who have achieved some of the competencies are awarded a Statement of Attainment.

Year 12 students have achieved VET Certificates in a number of different industry areas including Automotive; Business Services; Information Communications Technology; Film, TV, Radio and Multimedia; General Construction; Hospitality; Tourism; and Textiles, Clothing and Footwear.
