

# Curriculum Fact Sheet

## Classical Languages Course for 2021

### Key Points

- In September, the Board approved the renaming of the *Modern Languages Framework* to the *Languages Framework*.
- The accreditation period for the *Latin Beginning* and *Continuing* courses 2014-2020 will conclude in December 2020.
- *Beginning Classical Languages 2021-2024* was accredited in September 2020. This course currently makes provision for delivery of Latin, Classical Greek and Sanskrit.
- *Continuing Classical Languages 2021-2024* was accredited in September 2020. This course currently makes provision for the delivery of Latin.
- The courses are ready for implementation in 2021

### Teachers will need to:

1. **Review and rewrite their Programs of Learning, to include the content of the new course.**
2. **Develop assessment tasks that reflect requirements outlined in the *Languages Framework*.**
3. **Create new rubrics for each assessment task, using the new and separate Achievement Standards for Years 11 and 12.**

### Professional Learning

To assist teachers with writing new rubrics and programs of learning, the BSSS has generated the following TQI accredited online professional development opportunities.



#### **Writing a Program of Learning Online Course**

Teachers work through 5 activities which focus on curriculum and how this is enacted in the classroom. The final activity is focused on writing a program of learning for the relevant subject area.
