Food Courses for 2021

Key Points

- The new *Hospitality A/T/M/V*, *Food Studies A/M* and *Food Science and Nutrition A/T/M* courses will be available for delivery in 2021.
- Each course has been developed under a different framework.
- *Hospitality A/T/M/V* has been written under the *Technologies Framework* to meet the current course specifications. The scoping for VET remains much the same for now, but the Hospitality training package is under national review.
- *The Food Studies A/M* course is written under the *Industry and Services Framework*.
- The new *Food Science and Nutrition A/T/M* course has been written under the 2020 Science Framework.
- The current *Food and Resource Management Framework* will expire in December 2020.
- The *Food for Life* course expires in December 2020.
- The components of this course have been further developed in two new courses: *Connected Learning* and *Food Studies*.

Teachers will need to:

1. **Review the new courses and rewrite their Programs of Learning, to include the content of the new courses.**
2. **Develop assessment tasks that reflect requirements outlined in the new courses and the relevant Framework.**
3. **Create new rubrics for each assessment task, using the new and separate Achievement Standards for Years 11 and 12.**

Writing a Program of Learning Online Course
